Must-try restaurants

SAVOUR THE TASTES OF THE ISLAND

WOLF IN THE FOG

A local culinary anchor, Wolf lives up to its reputation by capturing Tofino's spirit through its hip-meetschill vibe. Chef Nicholas Nutting has a simple cooking approach that honours local ingredients from the island's fishers and farmers, as well as foraged goods from Tofino's forests and shores. Start with the potatocrusted oysters before moving on to the Green Soul, a seasonally rotating vegetarian dish, or one of the hearty Plates for Two, such as the whole crab or the island chicken with cauliflower, potato and butter chicken sauce.

SHELTER

Guests will delight in memorable meals served in Shelter's cozy, fireside dining room, elevated loft area or lively patio. Chef Matty Kane prepares dishes accentuating some of the region's freshest flavours (with free-run poultry from island farms and herbs cut from the restaurant's backyard garden). Start with the just-baked sourdough, crispy calamari or warm olives, before enjoying the warm chevre or kale Caesar salads. When it comes to mains, think Panko-crusted lingcod burgers and red Thai coconut curry, featuring salmon, cod, clams and mussels.

Rhino Coffee House's all-day breakfast includes wraps filled with bacon, scrambled eggs, avocado and more. Try The "Bro" Nut, which brings fried eggs and other fixings to the savoury doughnut.



LUNCH

Tacofino has made waves in other parts of B.C., but the original food truck is still the spot to dive into tacos, burritos and gringas filled with seared albacore, beans, tempura ling cod and pork.



DINNER

A local favourite since opening in 2014, Kuma serves Japanese-style comfort food, ranging from kimchi stew to salmon bowls and ramen filled with tofu, veggies, braised pork belly and marinated eggs.
