



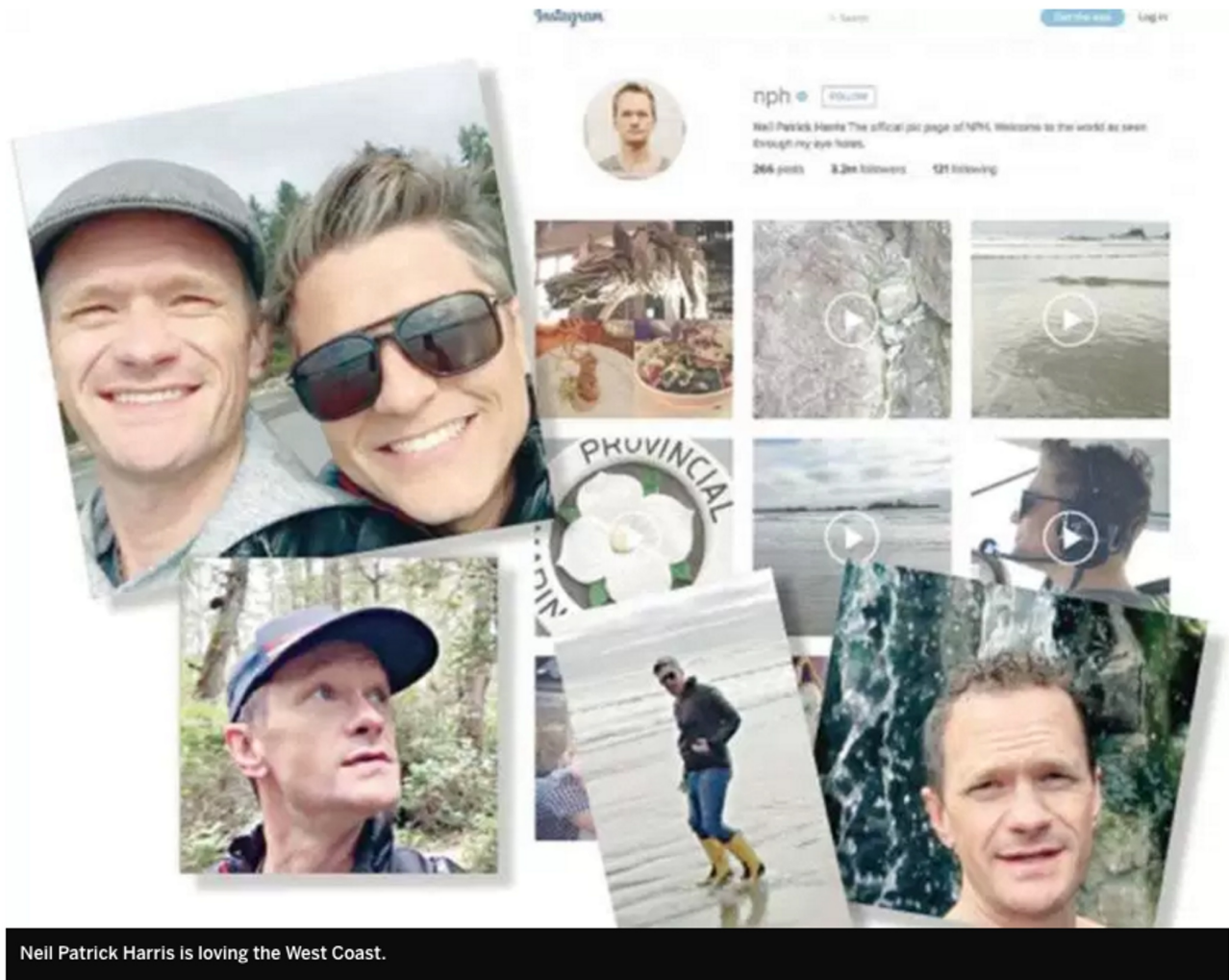
'Canada rocks!': Neil Patrick Harris shares Tofino love on Instagram

Neil Patrick Harris only had the Best Time Ever for one season, but the stage and screen star was apparently living up to the show's name in Tofino on the weekend.

"I'm not sure that I've ever taken this many photos or videos of any place in my entire life. It's so beautiful here. Canada rocks!" said the actor, singer and dancer during a recorded stroll on Chesterman Beach that he shared with his 3.2 million Instagram followers, along with a vacation video of husband David Burtka, 40, doing dance moves on the beach wearing yellow gumboots.

While Harris, best known for the CBS sitcom *How I Met Your Mother* and hosting the Tony Awards and Oscars, was here to celebrate his 12th anniversary with Burtka, 40, and their two children, he had another reason for being on B.C.'s west coast.


Their weekend getaway coincided with the start of production in Vancouver on *A Series of Unfortunate Events*, the new Netflix series inspired by Daniel Handler's best-selling Lemony Snicket book franchise.

Harris plays the villainous Count Olaf in the series, which relates the trials and tribulations of three orphaned children during their quest to unlock the mystery surrounding their parents' deaths.

The eight-episode series, directed by Barry Sonnenfeld and co-starring Patrick Warburton, Malina Weissman and Louis Hynes, began its four-month shoot in Vancouver on Monday.

Harris and Burtka's weekend adventures in and around Pacific Rim National Park included aerial tours, soaking in Hot Springs Cove ("hot spring heaven"), beachcombing, wilderness hikes and fine dining.
